## Editorial Initiative—Plastic Ban? Yes, We Can!

Every year, Buniyaad Playgroup and Nursery conducts the Editorial Initiative, an inter-nursery competition based on topics that are socially-relevant. **Plastic Ban? Yes, We Can!** was the subject the Editorial Team hit upon for 2018-19.



Plastic pollution has become one of the most relevant topics today especially in Maharashtra and we could vividly see the efforts of the teachers, the support of the parents and guidance of the volunteers in finding and educating themselves about the alternatives for plastic in our day-to-day lives. The competition was held on 31st August, 2018 across the nine nurseries. The Editorial Initiative kick started 6 weeks ago with the volunteers explaining the harmful effects of plastic to the teachers.

Teachers then educated children and parents, on how indiscriminate use of plastic has been affecting the environment. They organised meetings with parents to discuss how they can help society by bringing about changes at the family level.

Sub-topics of this project were; ways of replacing plastic at home, at office and public places, how plastic can be avoided during festivals, birthday celebrations and also during travel. Ideas poured in, and the quality of the projects was exemplary.

The beautiful miniature solutions to the problem of plastic were made out of recycled cloth, jute, clay and metals. Team Buniyaad applauds the support of teachers and parents to bring a healthy change in our lives.
